Slippery elm powder is derived from the inner bark of the slippery elm, *Ulmus rubra*. A rich source of fibre and mucilage.

GENERAL FEEDING GUIDE:

Horses: 2 tablespoons- best given moist. Can be blended with cold water and added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Dogs:

Small: 100mg (0.1g) to 200mg (0.2g)- best given moist. Can be blended with cold water and added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Medium: 200mg (0.2g) to 400mg (0.4g)- best given moist. Can be blended with cold water and added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Large: 400mg (0.4g) to 800mg (0.8g)- best given moist. Can be blended with cold water and added to food or as directed by your veterinarian.

Avoid administering Slippery Elm to an animal that is being administered any other medication that needs to be absorbed through the gut wall.
